Then you will be entertained by the unforgettable sounds of the Fado, the Portuguese guitar and Portuguese folklore which dates back to the very roots of the nation. Half Day Lisboa City Tour



Departure from the hotel in direction to the Terreiro do Paço (Praça do Comércio), considered to be one of the most beautiful squares of Lisbon and the Archaeological Nucleus of Rua dos Correeiros (NARC) where you can see the base of the «gaiola» (birdcage) structure invented by the 18th century engineers to resist earthquakes such as the one that destroyed the city in 1755. The group will then continue

on to Belém, another earthquake-related area of the city and which today's one of the most iconic historical sites of Lisbon.

A visit to the historical centre of the city will then be followed by LUNCH in Belém.

After lunch the tour continues to the outskirts of Lisbon and the breathtaking resort of Kings for those who choose to take part in the **FULL DAY** tour.

AFTERNOON PART OF THE TOUR

After lunch you will have free time to enjoy one of the most beautiful villages of Portugal. Sintra is famous for its royal palace, its craft shops and the most famous pastry shop "The Piriquita" where you can taste one of the traditional pastries (queijada or travesseiro) and have a drink if you feel up to it.





Depart towards Cabo da Roca the westernmost point of Europe and continue along the coast passing the famous Guincho beach towards Cascais where you will be able to see "Boca do Inferno" (Hell's Mouth) and the magnificent Bay of Cascais. Return to Lisbon via Estoril which is the favourite resort of Kings and

nobles since the 19th century. During the 20th century this area was the favourite spot for exiled Royal families fleeing from World War II. Here too met the spies of Europe and its elite intellectuals and politicians. The famous Casino and the Estoril Palace Hotel today represent the best of luxury and elegance. Even Fleming was inspired here for this was where James Bond was born and the inspirational setting for the first book *Casino Royal*. Return to the hotel. The Tour will begin from 9.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m..
